

# Highland Lakes Camp & Conference Center

## Summer Rental Rates & Amenities - Camp

### Campus Day Use Fee: \$15

- Each individual attending a conference or event on the Highland Lakes Camp and Conference Center grounds, but is not paying for HLC lodging, any per person fee based recreational activity, or a banquet alone will be responsible to pay a Guest Fee of \$10 per day he / she is on the grounds, plus meals.

### Meals: \$9.50 each.

- Special menus are available. Banquet, Catering, and Delivery options available on request.

## Lodging Rates

Rates are per individual, per night unless otherwise stated. Meals not included.

### Bunk House: \$35

- Bunk Room Style w/Bunk beds
- Bring your own twin size bedding
- Restrooms in the building
- Air Conditioning / Heating

### Private Rooms: \$65 single occupancy, \$45 per person per night for double occupancy

- 1 Queen & 1 Twin Bed or 1 Queen & 1 twin bunk bed
- Linens & towels provided
- Private Bath
- Air Conditioning / Heating

### Kilburn Cottage: \$125 per night; \$50 cleaning fee

- 1 king bed & 1 queen bed
- Linens & towels provided
- Kitchenette and dining area
- Private bath
- Air Conditioning / Heating

### The Upper Room: \$175 per night; \$50 cleaning fee

- Main Bedroom: 1 queen bed & 1 bunk bed with double bottom & twin top
- Bunk Room: 3 bunk beds & 1 queen bed
- Linens & towels provided
- Kitchen and dining area
- Each sleeping area has private bathroom
- Air Conditioning / Heating
- Balcony porch

### RV Park: \$50 per night

- Full hookup with water, sewer, electricity (30 or 50 amp circuits)
- Bath house available
- \$250 weekly

## Reservations

Reservations are confirmed through a signed contract and deposit. A 20% nonrefundable deposit and signed contract must be returned within one month of date contract issued. This signed contract commits to pay for 90% of the expected number of guests. Final payment due 10 days from final issued invoice. All buildings are subject to Fire Marshal capacities.

## Amenities and Recreation Options

### Amenities Included in the summer camp rates:

All recreational activities must be submitted to HLC Administration for approval 3 weeks prior to event.

Ranges: Archery, BB Guns

Baseball Fields, Basketball Courts, Sand Volleyball Pits, Soccer Field, Ping Pong Tables, Disc Golf, Horseshoes, GaGa Ball, Human Foosball, Cornhole, Hiking Trail, Fishing (bring own equipment & bait)

Staffing to include: Certified Lifeguards, Certified Challenge Course Facilitators, Medical (Health Technicians)

### Available Amenities for an ADDITION FEE with advance reservation:

**WATER ACTIVITIES:** Lake activities are subject to weather conditions and safe water level/conditions.

#### **Ski Boat: \$15 per person**

- Minimum of 16 people.
- Used to pull 8-passenger banana water sled.
- Price includes: boat driver, fuel, lifejackets, and lifeguard(s).

#### **Lakefront Inflatables: \$10 per person**

- Minimum 16 people.
- Floating obstacle course, fun barge, and Blob.
- HLC lifeguards must be on duty at all times. Participants must wear a provided lifejacket. For large groups, participants will be instructed to rotate through lakefront activities.

#### **Stand-up paddle boards & 2-person kayak: \$15 per 1/2 hour; \$25. per hour**

#### **Swimming Pool: \$150 per hour**

- HLC lifeguards must be on duty at all times.

Rental groups are limited to a **maximum of 3 hours per day** for scheduled activities at either the pool or lakefront.

### **CHALLENGE COURSE**

#### **Hexapod: \$15 per person, 1 hour session - 45 element self-guided High Ropes Course**

#### **Zip Only: \$12.50 per person, 1 hour session**

- Must be a minimum group size of 25 people.
- Participants must wear closed-toe shoes and be at least 12 years of age.

### **OTHER:**

#### **Archer's Quest: \$50 per hour**

- Must be a minimum group size of 10 players.

#### **Paint Ball: \$20 per person**

- Must be a minimum group size of 10 players.
- Includes safety gear, marker, and 200 paintballs.

#### **CAMPFIRE: \$50 - Subject to Travis County fire ban.**

## Conference Rooms / Meeting Options

The listed locations are reserved on first-requested/contracted basis.

#### **Miles Auditorium: \$600 per day**

- Holds up to 1,200.
- Permanent stage and sound booth. Sound, lighting, projection systems included. Requires approved technicians to operate.
- Events with outsourced production services will incur a production turnover fee of \$200.
- In house technician available @\$50 per hour.

#### **Miles Foyer: \$200 per day**

- Holds up to 200.

#### **Providence Tabernacle: \$350 per day**

- Holds up to 350.
- Permanent stage and sound booth. Sound, lighting, projection systems included. Requires approved technicians to operate.
- In house technician available @\$50 per hour.

#### **Conference Center: \$350 per day**

- Holds up to 350.
- Permanent stage.

#### **Conference Center Breakout Rooms: \$30 each per day**

- Holds up to 50.
- 6 separate meeting rooms.

#### **Independence Chapel: \$50 per day**

- Holds up to 30.

#### **Bunkhouse Meeting Room: \$50 per day**

- Complimentary if overnight bunkhouse lodging is 50% full.

#### **Highland Inn Meeting Room: \$150 per day**

- Holds up to 75.
- Mounted 70" TV.

## **Outdoor Venues:**

#### **Prayer Garden: \$75 per day**

- Holds up to 120.

#### **Mudd: \$150 per day**

- Holds up to 100.
- Permanent Stage.
